Notes to the Accounts for the year ended 31st March 2014

Note 1: Accounting policies

The accounts have been prepared under the historical cost convention as modified by the revaluation of certain fixed assets.

The going concern concept has also been assumed. This means that it is assumed that the Milton Keynes Reader Service will continue in its present form for at least a year.

Income is only recognised when it is received in the form of cash.

Note 2: Fixed Assets
